

CHABLIS 1^{ER} CRU

APPELLATION CHABLIS PREMIER CRU CONTRÔLÉE

An encounter with the thirteen different soils of the “Chablis Premier Cru” provides an understanding of the great Kimmeridgian soil in Chablis. The vineyards of the Premiers Crus flourish on superbly exposed south-east and south-west facing slopes, situated on both banks of the Serein, bringing to each wine its own unique personality. Thus, some Premiers Crus such as the Montée de Tonnerre or Côte de Léchet are fine and mineral whereas others, for example the Beauroy, are softer and more fruity, or floral and full-fleshed like the Fourchaume. Chablis Premier Cru reach their full splendour in six to eight years.
