APPELLATION CHABLIS GRAND CRU CONTRÔLÉE

Renowned worldwide, the “Chablis Grand Cru” are known by wine lovers everywhere as the kings of the appellation. Coming exclusively from the right bank of the Serein at Chablis itself, the vineyards make up an ensemble of 100 hectares (240 acres) most of which have a south-west aspect, the famed Grands Crus Hill. Chablis Grand Cru are well formed and complete with an affirmed character that is enhanced with time. Before really opening out, they need five to eight years of ageing and can keep remarkably well. La Chablisienne harvest and vinifies several Grands Crus, including Les Preuses, Vaudésir, Les Clos, Blanchot and Grenouilles, of course...
